I just discovered "Something For Nothing" recently, and it's quickly become a favorite of all the post-*A Brand New Me* tracks that Dusty returned to Philly to do with the Gamble & Huff crew, I actually think this is bested only by "I Wanna Be a Free Girl" and "Goodbye". I think it's very atmospheric, and Dusty sounds lovely. The modulation (key change) at the end is a little jarring, but I'm still a fan. I won't be forgetting it anytime soon, Carole.

PS- if you listen between :12 and :20 in the MFSB version, you can **VERY** faintly hear Dusty, particularly the "S" sound at the beginning of the word "something"...turn up your volumes!


