



A few observations from me. Sitting on the front row was always a given for a real Dusty concert but if you're going to see this show, sit at least 5 rows back! I was on the front row and it spoiled my enjoyment, I just couldn't get a feel for the whole stage. For me the performances from Ellie Anne Lowe as Dusty/Mary and Francesca Jackson as Nancy were stand outs, they were both excellent and I doubt they could have found a better Dusty. The musicians, backing singers and dancers are all first class but sometimes the

voice of Dusty got drowned somewhat by their voices, something I know they can sort out. I'm a bit of a stickler when it comes to getting Dusty's look right and they did a great job with the costumes, which were mainly day wear, but less so with the wigs. I didn't mind the look with the black bow so much (though shorter at the back would be good 3) but the earlier ones need work! There are so many good wig shops even on the high street now, I'm sure this could also be put right. Being so close to Dusty (in an avid fan way) for so long, it's hard to disregard these things. Almost all the footage worked really well for me, except maybe 3 clips from the Australian Bandstand was one too many. There was great vibrancy during the dance routines, I especially loved the Motown segment and Dusty as a Vandella 🕮 Losing You and All I See is You were also pretty special. The holograms seem to have split opinions, I was disappointed, I found them a bit odd, the final one working best but Dusty seemed too far back, I was expecting her to be front of stage....maybe it's not possible. Again my view on these could have been coloured by my front row seat! The show is going to get better and better, it was only the second preview and I can't wait to go and see it again but this time sitting further back and being able to take in the whole staging. Lovely, moving finale with a sweet finishing touch.

I said I'd write down my thoughts on the show, the matinee of which I saw this afternoon. I should preface this by saying that the remarks and my preferences are wholly personal, and I already know from Lynn's post tonight that she feels differently about one aspect than I do (and I wholly respect her judgement): I am most definitely NOT the arbiter of all matters of taste!

I should start by saying that it was unlike any other musical tribute or show that I have seen before, and a great deal of that has to do with the inventiveness of the presentation. What you get in most cases is video footage of Dusty in many of her truly great performances at the rear of the stage, but with every sound track other than her solo voice stripped away. The vocals used sounded like the original recordings in almost

every case. Synchronised just about perfectly throughout are musical instruments (piano, brass section, drums and guitars I think) played on (or rather above and to the rear of) the stage by some pretty magnificent musicians. Not only are they musicians, but they play characters in the dramatisation of that part of Dusty's life covered, they dance, and they sing. And (always my favourite bit) there's a really first-rate trio of backing singers who perform live too. So what you get from a musical standpoint is generally Dusty on film plus live musicians and live backing singers. From time to time, the actor who plays Dusty (I'm ashamed to admit that I don't know her name because there are no official programs until next week, though I believe her name is Ellie Ann Lowe) assumes the role of soloist, and she does a great job. She also manages to remind you of Dusty without trying to look completely like her. Six dancers make up the cast. When dancing is the focus of the show, you appreciate their high standards and energy, but I have to admit to realising that when they were performing at the same time as a video was playing on the screen, then the screen was getting all my attention. All this is, of course, woven into what I believe is a reasonable presentation of some of the major events in Dusty's life from secondary school through to Memphis. In this context, I think it's important for those around my age, who have been AVID fans for well over 50 years, to remember that we often know perhaps too much to be objective about a production such as this. We know the music inside out and backwards, and when someone comes along to contemporise the story, we need to embrace it so that future fans can be afforded the opportunity to see and hear Dusty and to relish her contribution to our culture as we have been able to do.

Much has been written about the holographs. There are four songs featured using this medium - and I'm not going to spoil things by spilling the beans and naming them. Dusty's face is, as always, breathtakingly beautiful, but the technology is not perfect. Nor is it faulty. It is what it is, and it was a fascinating experience to watch it. But given the choice between more video footage versus more holograph, the video footage would have won my vote.

There were, for me, three very distinct musical highlights during the show. The first occurred at (I think) the end of 'In the middle of nowhere', when the entire cast started a very short, heavily gospel-influenced recap. I could have listened to the whole song done in that style. Then the live performance of 'I don't want to go on without you' was featured, but not showing Madeline Bell, Lesley Duncan, and Barbara Moore on the screen, but current video of the three 'live' backing singers - a clever little twist, since they were also on stage singing live. And the final, and for me, climactic pinnacle was the closing song, when again the entire cast assembled on stage and performed a totally new interpretation of 'Goin' back', which will always be my most treasured Dusty recording. It was stunning in its beauty and its impact, and was a fitting ending to what I consider a tremendous show.

Musical fads come and go, I know, but given that this was only the second public performance of the show, I don't recall seeing any obvious issues or errors. What I do feel, though, is that as a tribute to a talent of the calibre and significance of Dusty in out culture, everyone involved has done a damned fine job. I'd certainly recommend anyone with even only a slight interest in either Dusty or 60s music to go to see it. For fans, in my opinion, it's a must-see. And don't be surprised if, at times, your emotions take over - it's one of the lady's greatest talents that she could involve you in the emotions of her singing. What has happened in my case now is that the nostalgia of and for those days becomes sometimes overwhelming - it did today during the final song. And now there's a vehicle which can trigger all those emotions and provide a wonderful

entertainment at the same time. It's definitely a show which I shall go to see again.

And after promising not to go on and on, I fail yet again.
