





I went to see the Dusty musical again on Saturday afternoon. I hadn't seen it since the press night or indeed since the big cast change. There are many, many changes since I last saw it, so many that I can't even list them. Almost every one is for the better, there was only one major song change that I didn't care for. There's no longer any schoolgirl scenes between Mary and Nancy and the Lana Sisters segment is much smoother and works far better. I should probably have sat with a notebook to remember everything but that was never going to happen! Praise though to Alison Arnopp, she has a big voice and without sounding like Dusty, could carry off the songs without a problem. There is less Dusty footage as has been mentioned before and in the main I was ok with that. The only disappointment for me was All I See Is You. It's a special song for me and many fans and on the last two occasions when I saw the show, 'Norma' was standing to the side of the stage singing to Dusty on screen, I found it very emotional and it got huge applause. It's now changed so that Norma and Mary/Dusty are at opposite sides of the stage in front of the curtain singing to each other before the curtain lifts towards the end for Dusty to finish the song on screen. It had far less impact for me that way. Originally I'd loved how Dusty's image was static on screen as Norma sang her part. It loses something for me this way.

I miss one or two of the old cast members but good to still see Francesca as Nancy and I accepted Alison's Dusty portrayal much easier than I thought I would after seeing Ellie in the part 4 times. She's studied her subject, that's clear and compared to those early days, she now has decent costumes to wear and wigs (hallelujah!), though there are still two I would bin! She also, helped by script changes, makes Dusty more sympathetic and likeable, which was needed. There are highlights throughout that got the audience clapping and whooping but the finale is what brings people to their feet. It's so uplifting and how a finale should be, people were up and dancing and the cast got a deserved standing ovation.

I feel so sorry for the cast and crew that they got such a hard time from the press who went over and above what is usually expected in a critique. I spoke with a group of people after the show who were standing in the foyer discussing the show. Jeremy had been listening while I was talking to Alison and he said they

were praising it to the rafters, so I butted in They all loved it. I've said it all before about the holograms and this show would totally work without them! The show has suffered with lower ticket sales since the press night, which is a real shame but I would certainly not hesitate in recommending it to any fan or even anyone who just knows Dusty music and wants to see a musical about her. Go before it finishes, there may be a tour but it certainly wont be for a while and it really deserves to go out with a bang.
