I remember seeing the Motown Revue at the Leicester Odeon, the place was half empty as not many people then had heard of Motown.

Dusty helped change all that a couple of weeks later with that television program that started it all off.

At the time it was a gamble on her part, she really has to take an enormous amount of credit for what she did in promoting that 'new' sound.

A year earlier the 'lads' at our engineering factory in Northampton organized a trip to The Nottingham Goose Fair on a Friday night, it is the sort of thing you did when you were eighteen ! On the way back we called in at Leicester services on the M1. We could all take our beer ok which was fortunate because just inside we met up with Dusty and Madeline Bell who had stopped off for a coffee.

She was great and so totally natural and really could have been just anybody.

I never saw her perform unfortunately.

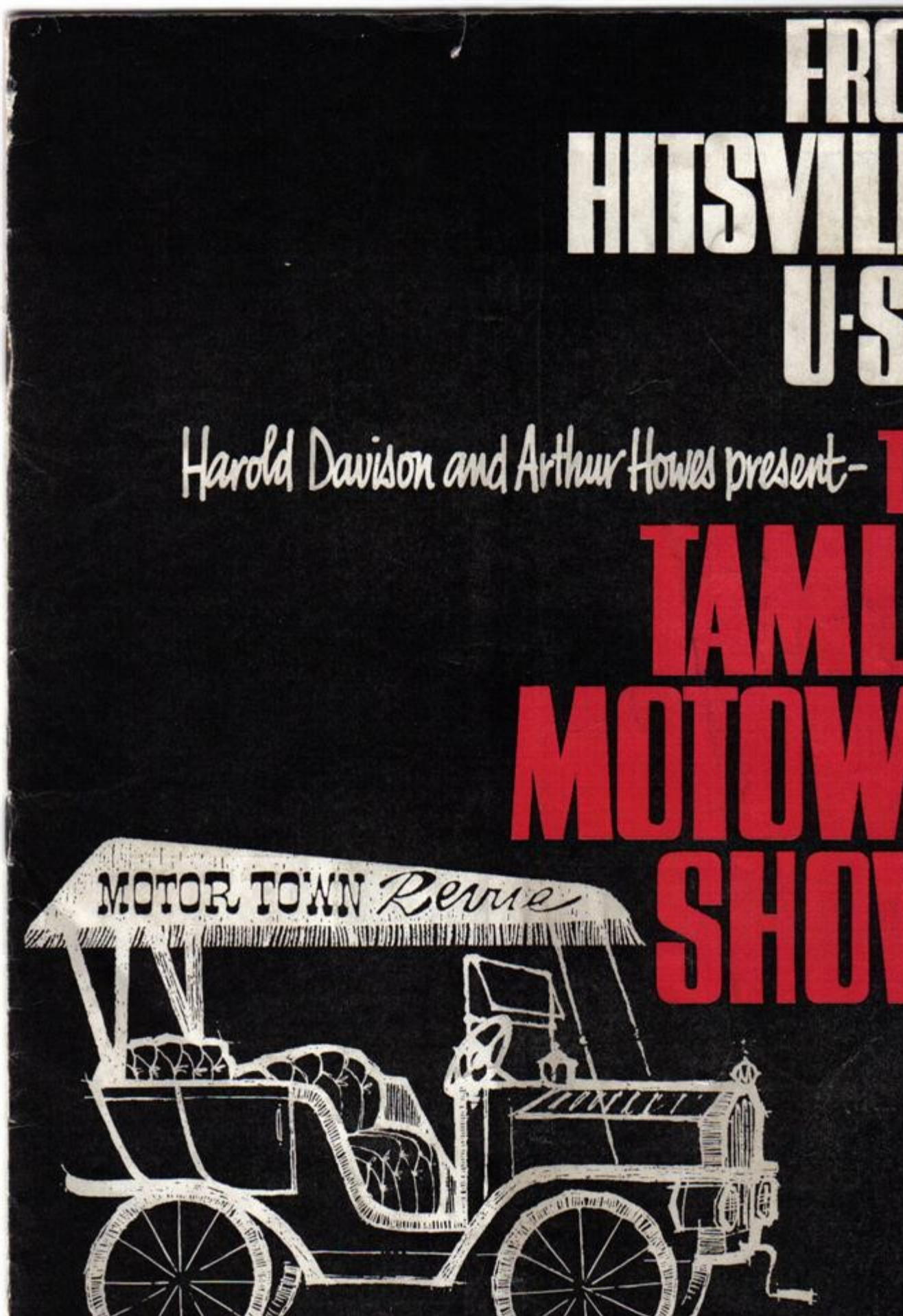
