So as it was nice but cold day here in London I took the SilverLink train to Brondesbury on Kilburn High Road and soon found Fordwych Road and No 87 birthplace of Mary O'Brian. Fordych Road is road of semi detached three storey houses, No 87 is attached to No 85 and is called Fordwych House, a Day Hospital for Camden and Islington Mental Health and Social Care Trust. The building is painted white and has these dreadful tatty fir trees planted in the front garden area. A blue plaque would certainly brighten the building up!!.

I walked up Fordwych Road to Mill Lane turned left and was making my way to West Hampstead Station when I came across Sumatra Road(home of the young Mary O'Brian). As we do not know what number Mary lived at I just had a quick look, Sumatra Road is a road of two storey terrace houses with bay windows, some having loft conversions. I stood there and imagined young Mary practising her hockey in the street.

Time to go home I thought til I saw a bus heading for Golders Green, why not take a look at the Hippodrome. The Golders Green Hioppodrome situated right next to the Bus Terminus and Tube Station, is now closed as a performance venue, according to a poster near the entrance the BBC last used the site in 2005. It was the home of the BBC Concert Orchestra until then, but they now give performances at the Mermaid Theatre (where the Dusty tribute concert was held). It is a listed Grade II building and if you are thinking of buying it and opening a Dusty Museum it will cost you £5.8M. There are few sites on the Hippodrome if you enter Golders Green Hippodrome in the search engine. I then took the tube home.






