If I had to pick a solo single, I'd go with 'It Goes Like it Goes'. It's another one that's never talked about, for some reason.

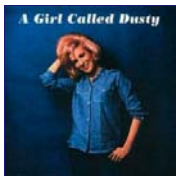
I'm with Clare on A Very Fine Love and am hoping it's going to get a re-release soon.

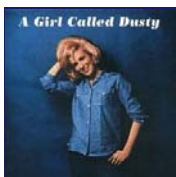
