	Two programmes of the auditions and heats, recorded late last year, were broadcast on BBC One on Saturday night.
	Since then, she has been in intensive rehearsals in London preparing to battle it out to win enough viewer votes to keep her in the competition each week.
	She said: "It's going astoundingly well. It's going to be a really good show because we've been working really hard.
	"To me, Dusty Springfield is the best 60s female artist. Every time I do a Dusty Springfield song in the show it always brings the house down. People old and young have so much warmth and nostalgia for her, it's a shame they didn't really show her when she was alive."
	Although it's early days, Katy is confident she could go on to win the show and scoop the grand prize of a three-month contract performing with Legends In Concert in Las Vegas.
	She will be cheered on by husband Andy Hodge, mum Carolyn and dad Robert.
	Andy said: "She has worked hard for it and national television exposure will give her career a major boost. Although we all miss her while she is locked away with the BBC, we will all be rooting for her."
	Katy was born in Chalfont St Peter and went to school at St Clement Danes in Chorleywood.
	She said: "When I was 15 I used to take my piano up to The Bell pub at Chartridge and do a set and then go to school the next morning."
