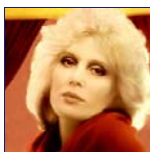

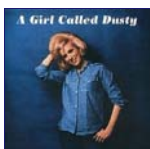

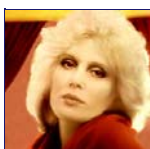

We actually thought all three had good voices, which I think comes across if you watch the show again and try and forget that they are supposed to be Dusty, arm movements and all. The smaller girl just felt wrong as a Dusty, Simon thought she would have made a good Brenda Lee! Nicola, the younger one, could have a future as a singer but on the night she was very nervous and inexperienced, and we thought she'd have had trouble with the live shows. So it was Katy. She's a professional and she'll be working hard right now to turn into a more convincing Dusty. When all is said and done, this is good for the real Dusty profile. If she'd been left out, we'd be moaning that she deserved to be in a Legends show.

I don't think the Beeb did themselves any favours by using the tiny theatre in Hoxton, to my mind it looked rather tacky. Hopefully, trailers this week will include the bigger venue at the BBC TV Centre and make it look far more glam and appealing. It's already very camp!

Can Katy be The One and Only?
