On Dionne's version she switches up the lyric to accomodate the gender change and keep the rhyme:

"...and you'll be my guy...if not, I'll just die..."

Dusty ignores it and just sings "...in love with this girl...if not, I'll just die..."

I prefer it that way, and most female covers since have followed suit. 🙋

I've heard several female versions, and for me Dusty's is still tops.

Ella does a sweet live version, Petula a pleasant-but-tentative cover, and Aretha's is just plain overwrought. It's even worse on her live version. Sometimes less really *is* more, ya know?
