NYTImes reports that Dusty is a featured performer but I wouldn't hold out hope for some rare performance clip. I am sure we will see the BBC Dusty TV series clip of YDHTSYLM. Whether or not there will be additional interview footage commenting on Dusty music and career is another tale.

Among those sharing memories are Paul McCartney, Elton John, Bruce Springsteen, Ozzy Osbourne, Gene Simmons, Whoopi Goldberg, Dionne Warwick, Twiggy and Ian."

Just finished watching this wonderful retrospective on the Dave Clark Five. Produced by Dave Clark, it's likely it has been shown in the UK. Probably so?

Anyway, I was a DC5 fan, so this reawakened some old time memories for me and my fondness for the group and they music and heavens knows, Dave Clark is/was gorgeous! But it was his ability to manage and produce that group that earns him high marks for near genius level. His skills negotiating his rights to their music was brilliant.

There are lots of clips of the group singing their hits and it covers the entire spectrum of their career from the sixties into the seventies.

Dusty does make a couple of cameos in the RSG clips (the Beatles interview) and surprisingly a all too short clip of her singing All Cried Out on a RSG show circa 1964/65. Grabbed my Complete Dusty Springfield and found no reference to her singing this on RSG. so a bit of a mystery. However, it brings up an often communicated pet peeve that there are 'lost" Dusty clips out there. I have see pics of Dusty from this clip, but don't have the time right now to go through them all to see if I can locate one.

Also, on one Ed Sullivan appearance it ends with Dave walking cross stage to greet Ed and Ed saying "The DC% are heading back to London for a Royal Command (Variety???) performance..or words to that effect. Next a video clip of the Queen is seen heading into a theater bejeweled as always and then a clip of the DCS singing Georgia On My Mind. A pic is flashed on screen afterward showing the royal receiving line after the show and I could swear Dusty is in it but only partially seen. She did do one royal variety show back in 1965. I'll have to go back and freeze frame the DVR at that spot and check again.

So, all in all, a worthwhile trip down memory lane and fascinating look at one of the biggest groups of the 1960's...
