

She looked at the screen that was showing a 60's Dusty and said that it was her mum who looked just like Dusty, especially in the 60's. To be honest, I can't say I noticed if Tamsin sounded like Dusty on DD, probably not because that's so tough to do, I just thought she sang the songs well. Some people think it doesn't matter, but whenever Dusty is portrayed, be it on film or stage, I do think the illusion of looking like Dusty matters, I'd be totally blown away and astounded if they could manage the voice too. For a film I would always want the real Dusty voice, no point to it otherwise.
