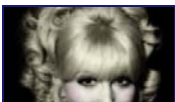

By the time she has finished the sentence, she is bouncing on its blue and white striped ticking. "Mmm. Pretty good. Comfortable."

She fixes the assistant with a luminous grey gaze. "Have you tried?"

His neat black coat almost quivers with dismay, his expression nicely conveying what would happen to him if he were caught joyously bouncing up and down on a store exhibit.

"You should. You've seen all those advertisements saying choose your mattress carefully — you're choosing for life. How can you tell what suits you till you've had a good night's sleep on it first. But I like it. I want it. How much is it?"

The assistant murmurs "£300, tadam."

"Sure, she's serious," says a "maid." "She likes it. She wants it. That's Dusty."

Let's go down to the kitchen department. After all, I'll be spending half my life in the kitchen.

Her friends look amazed. "You what?"

Dusty gives them one of the looks that have made her a byword in recording studios. Then she giggles. "Well I might."

There are explanations. Given a kitchen, Dusty can make the finest scrambled eggs in London, and she can turn out a passable Irish stew.

"And I can do a steak," says Dusty over her shoulder.

In the kitchen department we look at copper-bottomed pans. Great big shining ones you might buy for a family of 10. "Just what I want," says Dusty.

Murmurs in the background. "Sure I'll be living on my own," says Dusty, "but have you ever known me without a house full of people?"

Dusty thinks she'll take advice on her kitchen. "Not interior decorators, just people who'll do what I want."

"I want Spanish ceramic tiles for my kitchen floor, and one of those American-type gas stoves you push in and out. Do you have those?"

The assistant regrets. "I'll find out the name of the maker and you'll have them," says Dusty; "and I want a giant fridge with a freezer, because shopping on my way home would mean trying to buy chops in mid flight. And I want easy working surfaces and . . . Hey! Everybody. Look at him."

Him is a wooden rocking horse, set by a gifted display manager in the centre of one of the kitchen room sets.

"Isn't he lovely? Can I buy him?"

She can, says the kitchen department assistant, but since he's only Display down here, perhaps she might prefer to buy him in the Toy department.

"Dusty's like that," says her manager. "She draws you into this magic circle where you do things you never would otherwise."

Dusty, zooming off weighed down with paper bags and parcels stuffed with animals, and a lot of leaflets on design, leaves me with a lingering thought.

Suppose I presented my husband with a little black-eyed doll for dinner instead of meat and two veg.

### KNOCK 'EM COLD

Although it's some time since she had a single in the NME Chart, there are few level-headed pop fans who would deny that **DUSTY SPRINGFIELD**—voted the World's Top Female Singer—will once again knock 'em cold at Wembley on Sunday!

At the time of going to press, Dusty hadn't made up her mind about the members she will present (who can blame her, when her repertoire of hits is such a large one), and it was a particularly difficult choice—considering how busy she is right now. She told NME: "I've got so many commitments going on at the moment, I keep worrying in case I get them mixed up! I'm booked in my **ANY (E) MUST BE DUSTY** series, a concert for the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh, a concert before Princess Margaret, and the NME show—all within the next week!"



**DUSTY SPRINGFIELD**  
The husky-voiced singer whose appearances span the international circuit. Real name, Mary O'Brien. Educated at convents in Bucks and London, and once worked as a laundry assistant and record salesgirl, joined The Springfield in 1960, and went solo in 1963.



**HARDLY** the sort of pose you expect the lady Springfield to adopt . . . but that's how bystanders saw Dusty arrive at London's Grosvenor House Hotel in Park Lane last Wednesday when she provided colour at a swish charity event, the Alexandra Ross Ball.

Miss Springfield, it seems, disagreed at the rising cost of living, increase in road taxes and spiralling petrol prices, and also possibly aware of the exorbitant price she has just paid for

a house in Kensington, had decreed it would be Economy Week, bought a tandem for two (chauffeur Alan Dunn was up front) and pedalled furiously from her Knightsbridge flat to Grosvenor House.

Halfway round Hyde Park Corner, however, her bicycle clips fell off, leaving those haggard commuters billowing in the breeze! But she made it—and here's Alan Dunn helping her out of the saddle.
